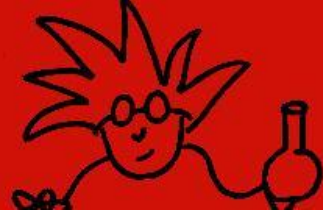


# Somerville Science Fair

Not sure that you want to register? Think the Science Fair is not for you? Think again! As always, all students are invited to participate in this noncompetitive and fun event. Solo or collaborative projects are welcome, with any level of adult participation acceptable as determined by you and your little scientist. Tri-fold display boards are an ideal way to present projects. They will be four to a table on the day of the fair.

Here are some suggestions to help start cooking up ideas.

There are five basic types of science projects. Click on the purple for an example of each.

1. An [Experiment](#) is a test done to answer a specific question.
2. A [Collection](#) is a group of similar things such as insects or leaves, organized and displayed in an interesting way.
3. A [Model](#) is a copy of something such as a heart, a car, a dinosaur, etc.
4. A [Report](#) is a written summary of information about a topic.
5. A [Demonstration](#) is a physical display explaining or showing something about a topic.

Identify a topic of interest and go! (although for safety reasons, no fire, combustibles nor heat sources are allowed).

## Schedule for the 2022 Science Fair

**Today through Tuesday, March 1** - Register and work on your project

**Friday, March 4 - 8:00-8:45am** - Students set up projects in the Somerville gymnasium

**9am-2:45pm** - Students visit the fair with their classes in scheduled time slots.

**3pm** - Students dismantle and take home their projects.

\*Please note that this year the fair will take place in one day and is for students only to attend with their classes. There will not be an evening portion open to the public.
